The article describes the dependence of the concept of information on individual and ideological threats, the influence of information on the spirituality of our youth.

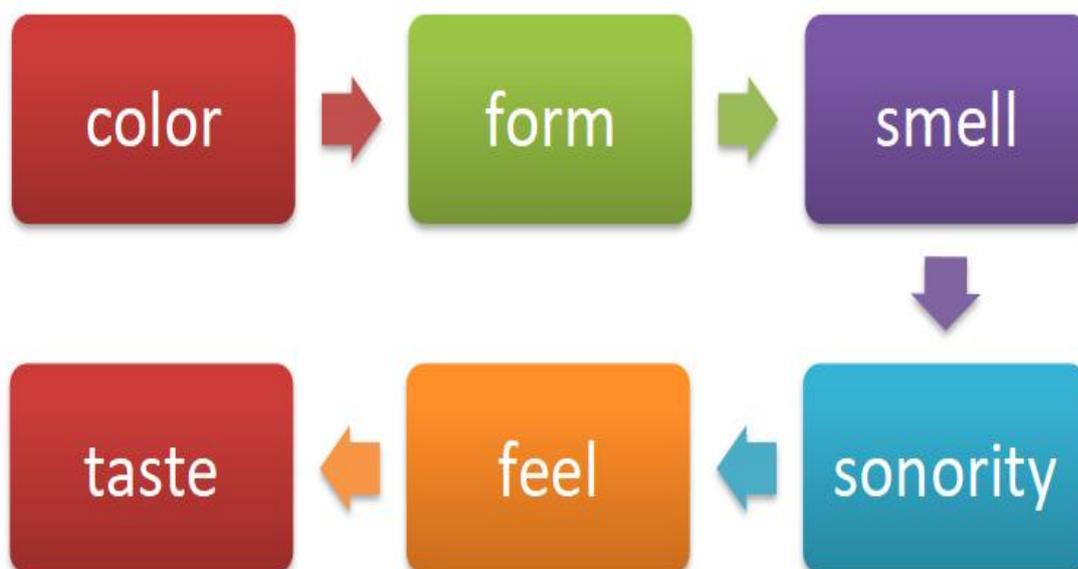

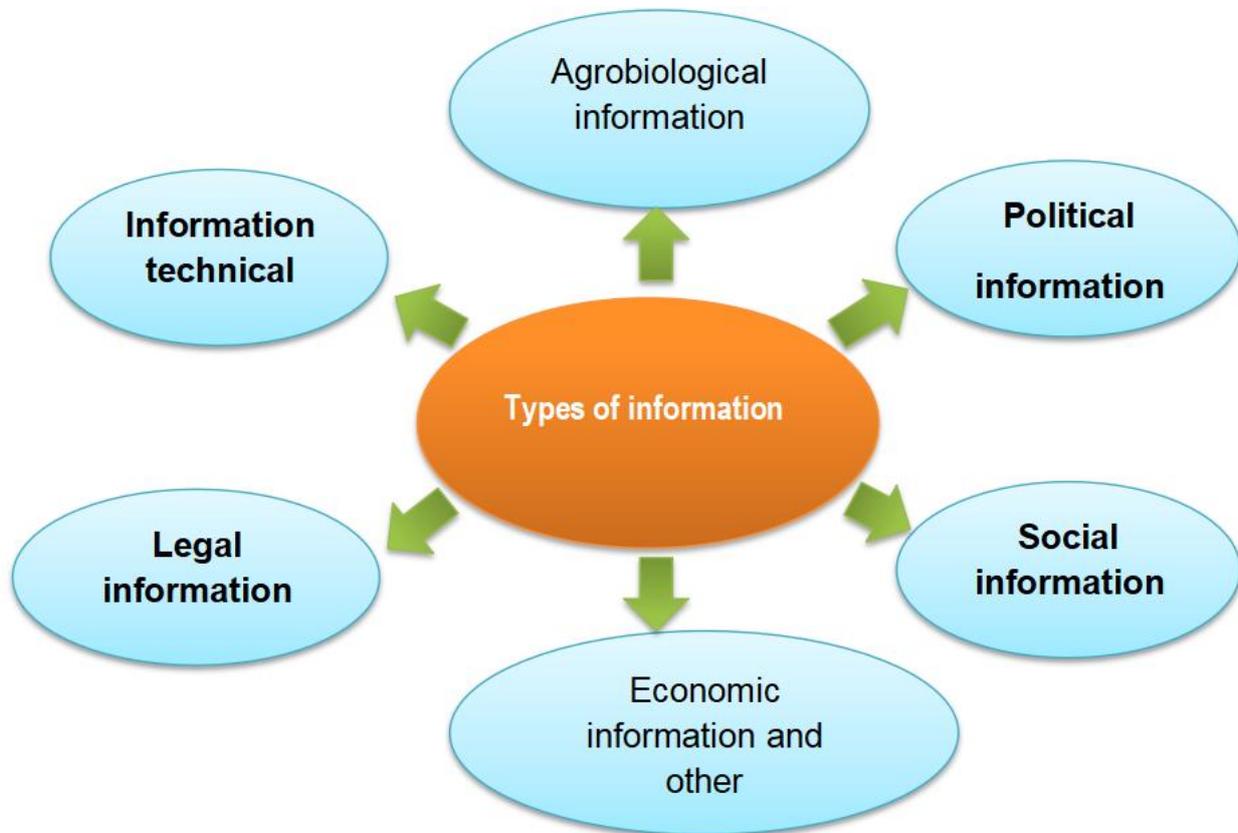
Concept of information, logical proof, signals, types of information, information security, youth spirituality, Internet.
