The core of the word art pedagogy "art" spread from the West and means art in translation. We know that when we talk about the types of art, music, visual arts, dance, theater come to mind. Combining all the above types of art with one term and using art as a direction in solving modern educational problems in pedagogy through art can be the basis for proving some of our scientific hypotheses.

### RESEARCH RESULTS

Today, the term "art" has taken a firm place in everyday use in scientific and colloquial language as an integral part. The most frequently used questions related to the word art of Internet search content showed more than 30 answers. When we divided these findings into categories according to their meaning, 4 different directions were identified. These are:

2. 2. Words related to the field of art: art critic, art director, art dealer, art manager, art catalog, art shop, etc.
3. 3. Names of events, exhibitions, art literature ("Art magazine", "Art Manege", "art periodicals", art dictionary) etc.
4. 4. defining the field of scientific and practical knowledge and activity, as well as the concepts arising from them: art therapy - art therapist, art therapeutic process, art therapeutic space, art methods, art technologies, etc., art pedagogy, art pedagogical process, art pedagogical activity, art pedagogical approach.

Based on the results of our small observation made above, we can see that the usual translation of the word "art" has become far from the truth. In the process of working with his patient, the art therapist works with the unique artistic creations of the patient. But we can't always call all the artistic creations that are created arbitrarily as an example of art, because if that's the case, we would be devaluing the beauty of art in some sense.

### CONCLUSION

Obviously, the modern use of "art" does not have the same irony. At the same time, it can be noted that the Uzbek equivalent of the word "art" with the word "art" (or with the word "artistic") conveys a certain semantic connotation and uniqueness of the concept. causes hardening.
