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EXPLANATIONS GIVEN TO MEDICAL TERMS IN ENGLISH AND UZBEK EXPLANATORY DICTIONARIES

The article shows the differences between the linguistic approach and explanatory methods of medical terms. English dictionaries are built on the basis of more scientific and technical descriptions, while Uzbek dictionaries describe medical terms in a simple and understandable way. Some medical terms in Uzbek dictionaries can be difficult to translate, especially if the terms are subject to language-specific variations. Interpretation of medical terminology is of great importance, especially in the teaching, translation and effective use of medical terms in the international medical system. The article analyzes the description of medical terms in each language and the main factors of their acceptance by specialists. Research methods

2. English dictionaries are more consistent with universal standards of terminology, while Uzbek dictionaries show more flexibility.
3. Synonyms and variants of the terms are more widely covered in English dictionaries.

CONCLUSION

There are specific aspects of English and Uzbek dictionaries in the interpretation of medical terms, and effective exchange of experience is necessary for both languages. The following proposals are put forward:

1. Bringing medical dictionaries in the Uzbek language closer to international standards.
2. Introducing the experience of short and concise comments in English dictionaries in Uzbek.
3. Harmonization of local and international approaches to the interpretation of medical terms.

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
