But because this method of making books was too expensive, the poor could not use it. They wrote on birch bark. As far back as the 10th century, paper appeared.

Including "the bird without the Book of reason", "knowledge is the light of reason", "Beauty is science and enlightenment". Such wise transplants can be continued again for a long time.
