**Annotation:** This article is devoted to the issues of improving the planning activities of prevention inspectors of the internal affairs bodies of the Republic of Uzbekistan. The article analyzes the tasks and functions of prevention inspectors from the point of view of the regulatory framework and identifies existing problems in planning activities. Proposals were put forward to strengthen information and analytical work, introduce digital technologies, and develop cooperation with the public. The experience of community policing in foreign countries was also studied, and the possibilities of its adaptation to the conditions of Uzbekistan were considered. The results of the study can serve to increase the effectiveness of crime prevention.

**Keywords:** Prevention inspector, planning activities, crime prevention, information and analytical work, public relations, community policing, foreign experience, internal affairs bodies.

Strengthening law and order and preventing offenses in the Republic of Uzbekistan is one of the priority areas of state policy. Prevention units of internal affairs bodies, in particular, prevention inspectors, play an important role in this process. In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated April 18, 2017 No. PP-2896, measures have been defined for the radical improvement of the activities of prevention inspectors, which introduced mechanisms for clarifying tasks, strengthening public cooperation, and assessing the effectiveness of activities[1].

The planning activities of prevention inspectors are the main factor in the timely identification of the causes and conditions of offenses, the systematic implementation of preventive measures, and the forecasting of the criminogenic situation. However, in practice, there are such problems as insufficient systematization of information and analytical work in the planning process, insufficient use of modern technologies, and incomplete consideration of territorial characteristics. This article is aimed at analyzing these problems and identifying ways to improve planning activities.

The research is based on the analysis of regulatory legal acts, a review of scientific literature, and comparative methods. The main sources were the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PP-2896 and the Regulations on Supporting Points of Appendices to it[1], as well as scientific articles on the activities of internal affairs bodies[2]. Foreign experience was analyzed on the basis of the United Nations Community-Oriented Police Manual[3] and international monographs[4]. The study used such methods as the SARA (Scan, Analyze, Respond, Assess) model for analyzing the criminogenic situation.

The planning activities of prevention inspectors are carried out on the basis of reference points and require taking into account the criminogenic situation, population size, and the characteristics of the territory[1]. In practice, information and analytical work plays an important role in planning: it is necessary to conduct a comprehensive analysis of the causes of offenses, a

phased study of the most vulnerable areas, and an assessment of the effectiveness of preventive measures[2].

The following proposals for improvement are put forward:

- Digitalization of the information and analytical system: implementation of special platforms for real-time monitoring of the criminogenic situation.
- Deeper consideration of territorial characteristics in planning: drawing up individual annual and monthly plans for each base point.
- Strengthening cooperation: planning joint activities with citizens' assemblies, mahalla committees, and other institutions.
- Training of qualified personnel: retraining of inspectors in information-analytical and forecasting methods.

These measures will serve to reduce the number of offenses and increase the effectiveness of activities.

The above proposals are inextricably linked with strengthening the personal responsibility of prevention inspectors and developing a system of public accountability[1]. Insufficient systematization of information and analytical work leads to a superficial nature of the activity[2]. The introduction of digital technologies will save inspectors time and increase the effectiveness of measures. However, its implementation requires material and technical support and advanced training. Comparative analysis shows that the scientific validity of planning is an important factor in the prevention of offenses.

In foreign countries (USA, Canada, Great Britain, Scandinavian countries), the community policing model is widely used[4]. The main principles of this model are: public consultation, prompt response to problems, population mobilization, and problem-oriented police (SARA model) [3]. For example, the creation of joint committees with the local population, long-term patrols, and the practice of comprehensive problem-solving have yielded effective results.

In the context of Uzbekistan, it is advisable to adapt this experience: integration with mahalla institutions, studying public opinion through digital platforms, and joint planning of preventive measures. In conclusion, improving the planning activities of prevention inspectors should be carried out by strengthening information and analytical activities, introducing modern technologies, and adopting foreign experience. This will serve to strengthen law and order and ensure the safety of citizens.
